

2017 Shanghai Government Scholarship
for International Students of Fudan University
(for Graduate Students)

1、Eligibility

- (1) Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens and in good health.
- (2) Applicants first have to apply and be offered a postgraduate enrollment qualification at Fudan University in September 2017
Applicants enrolled in the following programs are ineligible
 - I A joint degree program
 - II Majoring in one's native language or language literature majors of a third language (French, English, etc.)
- (3) Applicants for master's studies should have obtained a bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35; applicants for doctorate studies should have obtained a master's degree and be under the age of 40;
- (4) Applicants should not be holding any other scholarship provided by Chinese government.

2、Award details

Category A: Be exempted from tuition fee, providing living stipend (Master Student 3000RMB/month, Doctorate Student 3500RMB/month), free on-campus accommodation and Comprehensive Medical insurance for International students in China.

Category B: Be exempted from tuition fee and providing Comprehensive Medical Insurance

3、How to apply

- (1) Visit www.study-shanghai.org to complete the application online and print the form for Shanghai Government Scholarship.
- (2) Visit <http://admission.iso.fudan.edu.cn> from November 28, 2016 to February 19, 2017 to submit the application to Fudan University. Please choose "Self-support" as the "fund source". When fill in the application form, choose the option of "Shanghai Government Scholarship", and complete the application online.
- (3) Applicants must send all the required documents to Fudan University by post or in person before February 19, 2017, otherwise, it will be considered as a waiver of application.

4. Application documents required (hardcopy)

(1) Application Form for Shanghai Government Scholarship with the applicant’s signature and photo (print two copies)

Please visit <http://www.study-shanghai.org> to complete the application online and print the application form.

(2) Personal Statement for Scholarship.

The content should include (but not limited to) the reason for applying scholarship, family financial situation, study and work experience, individual rewards and special skills, etc. At least 1500 words in Chinese (Chinese-taught program) or English (English-taught program).

(3) The Diploma of highest degree conferred (master or bachelor) or proof of impending graduation (for applicants in their final year of study).

(4) Application Form for postgraduate program (can be downloaded from the website: <http://admission.iso.fudan.edu.cn/>) with personal signature and photo. Only after paying the application fee and passing the first review can the applicants download the form (pdf version) and print it.

(5) A copy of valid passport identification page, and it should be an ordinary passport and be valid until Sep. 30. 2017.

★The above-listed application document in Item 3 must be original or notarized copy, and with notarized Chinese or English translation if the original one is not in Chinese or English.

★All documents submitted for application will not be returned.

5. Result release Time

The applicant may check the result on <http://admission.iso.fudan.edu.cn/> approximately on April 15, 2017.

6. Others

(1) Scholarship students should register at Fudan University on the date specified by the university on admission notice. Students who arrive late without approval in advance will have their Scholarship status automatically cancelled. Students who have kept the admission but postponed their registration to the following academic year will have their scholarship status cancelled.

(2) Scholarship students MUST participate in annual scholarship evaluation. Scholarship holders who fail to meet the requirements will have their scholarship cancelled.

(3) Scholarship students could not change their major or study period in principle.
